

Telecommunications Regulatory Commission
Notice Concerning Consultation on Interconnection
[Gazetted 5 May 2011]

TAKE NOTICE THAT:

The Telecommunications Regulatory Commission, (the “Commission”) is responsible for ensuring fair competition in the telecommunications sector in the Virgin Islands (“VI”). As per the Market Review Final Statement published on the Commission’s website on 2 December 2010, the Commission is proceeding with the Market Analysis of Wholesale Call and SMS Termination on Individual Fixed and Mobile Networks and is planning to hold a public consultation on the results of such market analysis. This public consultation will set out the results of the market analysis, including the assessment if any of the following suppliers are dominant with respect to the termination of fixed and mobile voice calls and SMS on fixed and mobile networks.

Cable and Wireless (BVI) Ltd (“LIME”)

Caribbean Cellular Telephone Ltd (“CCT”)

Digicel (BVI) Ltd (“Digicel”)

Before determining that a public supplier is dominant with respect to a telecommunications service, under the Telecommunications Act, 2006, (the “Act”) the Commission is required to publish details concerning the consultation at least fourteen days prior to the commencement of the consultation. The Commission is now notifying the general public that it will be conducting a consultation concerning a Market Analysis of Wholesale Call and SMS Termination on Individual Fixed and Mobile Networks two weeks from the date of publication.
