LICENSE TO INSTALL AND OPERATE BROADCASTING STATION

VIRGIN ISLANDS COMMUNITY RADIO hereinafter called the "Licensee" is hereby authorised (subject in all respects to the Telecommunications Act and Rules) to establish, install, work and operate a broadcasting station (hereinafter called the "Station") at PO BOX 43 ROAD TOWN, TORTOLA, BVI until the 12 day of August, 2022 subject to the following conditions:-

1. The Licensee shall observe the provisions of the International Telecommunications Convention, 1974, and the Radio Regulations annexed thereto in so far as they are applicable to the Station.

2. Messages shall be sent only on the frequency within the band and by the type of emissions following:-

3. The call sign ZVCR is allotted to the Station and shall be used as prescribed by the said Radio Regulations, and the Telecommunication Rules.

4. The Station shall be used in such manner as not to cause interference with any other stations outside the authorised band.

5. The granting of this Licence does not authorise the Licensee to do any act which is an infringement of any copyright which may exist in any matter transmitted or received.
